Description

The National Indoor Sports Centre in Kingston, Jamaica, was designed and built by Trumbley & Hampton within budget and to a demanding schedule. Construction began in November of 2002, and the 200 ft clearspan 52,000 square foot facility was open for practice games June 14, 2003 in preparation to host the world for the 2003 International Netball Tournament in July. Financing was arranged by Trumbley & Hampton through Export Development Canada.

In September 2004, with the direct approach of Hurricane Ivan the facility was filled to capacity with people seeking shelter. After Hurricane Ivan ravaged the island of Jamaica, the undamaged facility served as a secure shelter while families rebuilt their homes.
